
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

12.The Sight Rail comes complete with a Windage Adjustable Rear Sight.

CAUTION: Always depress the Release Latch Button to engage or disengage the rail to minimize wear on the latch contact/locking surfaces and to ensure rail longevity.




3. Push the Release Button to remove the action spring and then remove the bolt carrier group.



4.Lift and push forward the Gas Tube Lever next to the Rear Sight Blade and remove the Gas. Tube/Upper Handguard assembly.



5.Depress the Leaf Spring under the Rear Sight Blade with a rear sight removal tool or a screw driver, and pull the Rear Sight Blade out at about 45° angle along the cut grooves inside the Rear Sight Block.



6.Remove the stock screw from the rear receiver trunnion and install the Base Block with either the original screw or the provided Stock Screw that comes with the kit. Make sure the Lower Latch of the Base Block is facing the receiver. Tighten the screw securely.



7. Holding the narrow, front end of the Sight Rail at an approximately 45° angle to the gun body, insert into the rear sight slot to click into position.



8. With the included Allen Wrench, loosen the two locking screws on the Sliding Interface Block of the Sight Rail, stopping right before the threads become completely disengaged. Be careful not to lose the locking screws.



9.Lower the Sight Rail onto the Base Block (Fig. 9.1). Pull the Sliding Interface Block rearward to obtain complete engagement between the Upper Latch in the Sliding Interface Block and the Lower Latch in the Base Block (Fig. 9.3). A 20mm forward-backward adjustment range is provided by the Sliding Interface Block to allow secure mount installation on different AK variants.

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
